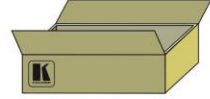
VM-2HN Quick Start Guide

This guide helps you install and use your product for the first time. For more detailed information, go to <http://www.kramerav.com/manual/VM-2HN> to download the latest manual or scan the QR code on the left.

Step 1: Check what's in the box

- VM-2HN 1:2 HDMI DA
- 1 Power supply (5V DC)

- 4 Rubber feet
- 1 Quick Start sheet



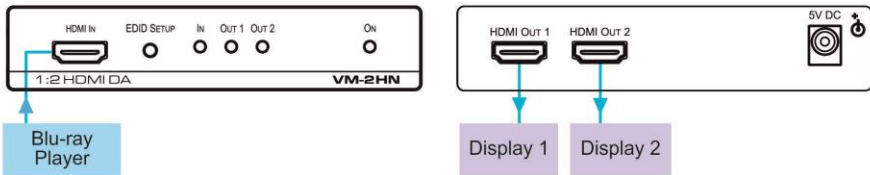
Save the original box and packaging materials in case you need to return your **VM-2HN** for service.

Step 2: Install the VM-2HN

Attach the rubber feet and place on a table or mount the **VM-2HN** in a rack (using an optional **RK-3T** rack adapter).

Step 3: Connect the inputs and outputs

Always switch off the power on each device before connecting it to your **VM-2HN**.



Always use Kramer high-performance cables for connecting AV equipment to the **VM-2HN**.

Step 4: Connect the power

Connect the 5V DC power adapter to the **VM-2HN** and plug the adapter into the mains electricity.



Step 5: Acquire the EDID

1. The first press of the EDID SETUP button displays the present EDID status similar to that shown in the next step.
2. The second press of EDID SETUP enters the read mode and each additional press cycles through the source options:
OUT 1 -> OUT 2 -> all LEDs flash slowly for auto-mix -> all LEDs flash quickly for a default EDID.
3. When the desired EDID source is reached, release the EDID SETUP button.
The **VM-2HN** reads the EDID for a few seconds. When finished, all LEDs return to display the present output connection status.

2.1 Achieving the Best Performance

To achieve the best performance:

- Use only good quality connection cables (we recommend Kramer high-performance, high-resolution cables) to avoid interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Do not secure the cables in tight bundles or roll the slack into tight coils
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality
- Position your Kramer **VM-2HN** away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust



This equipment is to be used only inside a building. It may only be connected to other equipment that is installed inside a building.

3 Overview

The Kramer DigiTOOLS® **VM-2HN** is a high-quality 1:2 HDMI distributor that takes one HDMI input, equalizes and reclocks the signal and distributes it to two identical outputs. The **VM-2HN** distributes signals having resolutions up to 4Kx2K and including WUXGA and 1080p.

In particular, the **VM-2HN** features:

- A maximum data rate of 10.2Gbps (3.4Gbps per graphic channel)
- HDMI support for Deep Color, x.v.Color™, Lip Sync, HDMI Uncompressed Audio Channels, Dolby TrueHD, DTS-HD, CEC
- HDCP compliance
- Kramer Equalization & re-Klocking™ Technology that rebuilds the digital signal integrity to travel longer distances
- I-EDIDPro™ Kramer Intelligent EDID Processing™, an intelligent EDID handling and processing algorithm that ensures Plug and Play operation for HDMI systems
- A default EDID for fast and efficient connection of the unit
The default EDID feature lets you connect the VM-2HN without having to connect a display to the output
- 3D pass-through
- A compact DigiTOOLS® enclosure with a 5V DC power source

3.1 Defining the VM-2HN 1:2 HDMI DA

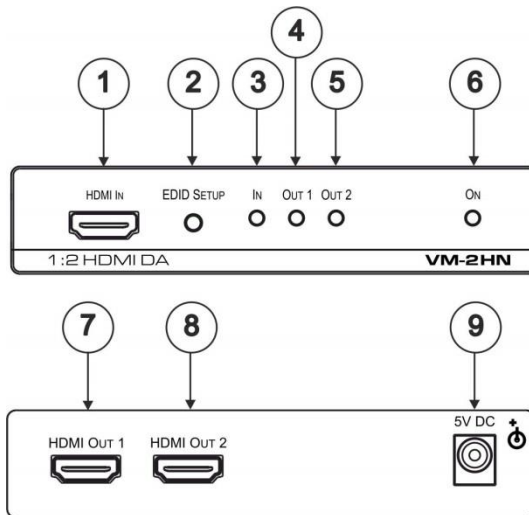


Figure 1: VM-2HN 1:2 HDMI DA

#	Feature	Function
1	HDMI IN Connector	Connects to the HDMI source
2	EDID SETUP Button	Press to capture the input EDID or select the default EDID (see Section 4.1)
3	IN LED	Lights when an active input signal is detected
4	OUT 1 LED	Lights when output 1 acceptor is detected
5	OUT 2 LED	Lights when output 2 acceptor is detected
6	ON LED	Lights when the device is powered on
7	HDMI OUT 1 Connector	Connects to HDMI acceptor 1
8	HDMI OUT 2 Connector	Connects to HDMI acceptor 2
9	5V DC Connector	Connects to the 5V DC power supply

4 Connecting the VM-2HN



Always switch off the power to each device before connecting it to your **VM-2HN**. After connecting your **VM-2HN**, connect its power and then switch on the power to each device.

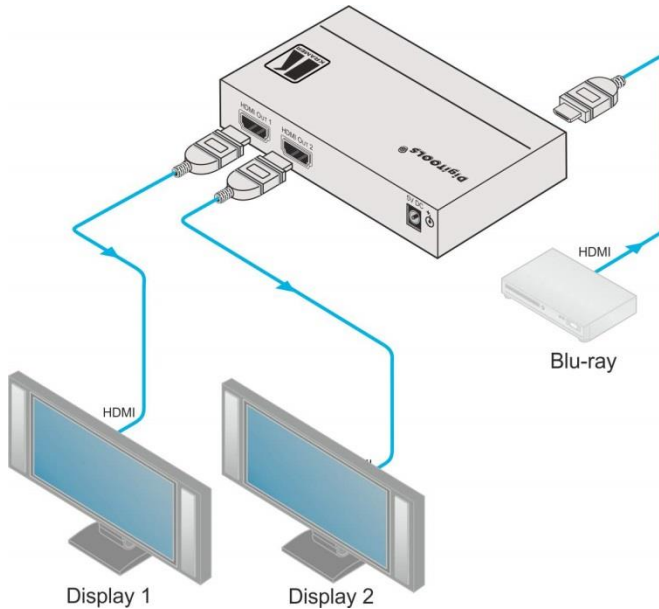


Figure 2: Connecting the VM-2HN 1:2 HDMI DA

Connect the **VM-2HN** as illustrated in the example in [Figure 2](#):

1. Connect an HDMI input source (for example, a Blu-ray player) to the HDMI IN connector.
2. Connect the two OUTPUT connectors to up to two HDMI acceptors, as follows:
Not all outputs need to be connected.
 - HDMI OUT 1 connector to HDMI acceptor 1 (for example, display 1)
 - HDMI OUT 2 connector to HDMI acceptor 2 (for example, display 2)
3. Connect the 5V DC power adapter to the power socket unit and then connect the adapter to the mains electricity (not shown in [Figure 2](#)).
The ON LED lights.

4.1 Acquiring an EDID

To acquire an EDID, press the EDID SETUP button as follows:

1. The first press of the EDID SETUP button displays the present EDID status similar to that shown in the next step.
2. The second press of EDID SETUP enters the read mode and each additional press cycles through the source options:
 OUT 1 -> OUT 2 -> all LEDs flash slowly for auto-mix -> all LEDs flash quickly for a default EDID.
3. When the desired EDID source is reached, release the EDID SETUP button. The **VM-2HN** reads the EDID for a few seconds. When finished, all LEDs return to display the present output connection status. If an unconnected output is chosen or the EDID cannot be read, the **VM-2HN** loads the default EDID.

4.2 Force RGB Mode

The **VM-2HN** toggles between “Normal” and “Force RGB” modes.

To toggle:

- Press the EDID button for three seconds
All input and outputs LEDs flash depending on the selected mode:
 - In “Normal mode” (not forcing RGB), the LEDs flash once
 - In “Force RGB mode”, the LEDs flash four times

Note: After setting the Force RGB mode you must re-read the EDID from the display to update the Force RGB change.

Powering on the device identifies the mode as follows:

- In “Normal mode” (not forcing RGB), the LEDs flash once
- In “Force RGB mode”, the LEDs flash four times.

The default mode is “Normal”.
